WHAT'S UP? Wings Over Long Beach November 15-16, 2008

In 2008, the Airport will celebrate its 85th Anniversary from when the Long Beach City Council dedicated the initial acreage in 1923 to establish the first municipal airport in Southern California Completed in 1941, the existing Terminal Building, with its Streamline Moderne art deco style, was deemed a cultural heritage landmark in 1990.

Today, there are over 50 air carrier flights per day (66 authorized) that pass through the airport serving 3 million passengers per year.

It's not often the United States Air Force comes to Long Beach to celebrate Air Force Week and an anniversary. But that's exactly what will be happening the weekend of November 15-16, when a broad array of USAF aircraft will be on display during Wings Over Long Beach to celebrate Air Force Week and the Long Beach Airport's 85th anniversary.

The USAF will bring an "awesome collection" of fighters, bombers tankers and transports to the event, according to Dennis Lord, President and CEO of Wings Over Long Beach. Aircraft scheduled to be on display include a Long Beach-built C-17 Globemaster transport, a KC-135 Stratotanker, a UH-60 Black Hawk assault helicopter, an F-16 Fighting Falcon, a B-52H Stratofortress bomber, an MQ-1 Predator unmanned aerial vehicle, a P51-D Mustang fighter, an AT-6D Texas trainer, an L.A. Sherriff's Department's AS-350 AStar, and several civil airplanes, including an historic Douglas DC-3. Some aircraft will be open for public visitation, and more military aircraft may be added.

There will be many attractions for children in the Youngsters' Zone. "We'll have a mini C-17 and mini F-16s that kids can ride in, and Air Force and civilian crews will be on hand to talk about the aircraft on display," Lord said. "Additionally, games and crafts will be available and a DJ will keep the kids grooving. Entertainment will be provided by the Air Force Band of the Golden West and the Air Force Honor Guard Drill Team."

The mission of Wings Over Long Beach is: "Provide direction and support to our youth seeking employment and sustainable careers in aerospace through industry and community partnerships.. Through aerospace related events and job fairs, interested youth will be provided opportunities for educational advancement through direct contact with industry partners that blends with the needs for an educated workforce."

Flying schools, colleges, aviation companies and aerospace organizations will be on hand to connect with local job seekers. Scenic or aerobatic rides in an open-cockpit Stearman bi-plane will be available. Long Beach Airport - the oldest municipal airport in California, along with Cal State Dominguez Hills and Dominguez Rancho will display information about the region's storied aviation history.

Volunteers are needed for a wide variety of jobs. If you are interested in volunteering, please fill out the form on the website for consideration and assignment. For many positions, previous experience is not required. We seek individuals with the ability to work congenially with the public, who have a love for aviation, and are willing to contribute to a successful event.

For those positions that require some experience (i.e.; ramp operations), please describe your experience level. Should the position you are interested in be filled, you will be offered other positions until all volunteer positions are filled. Wings Over Long Beach will be held at the end of Wardlow Road off Cherry Street, near the Boeing C-17 facility. Admission is \$5, with children under five admitted free. Parking is free and lots are located near the C-17 plant at the east end of Wardlow Road, off Cherry Avenue. A shuttle bus will run between the site and the Blue Line's Wardlow station.
